What is LEED-ND?





- Joint venture of USGBC, CNU, NRDC (SG)
- national certification for "smart" development
- Primary market: developersOther possible users : planners & local governments







What is LEED-ND for?

- · Whole, fractions, or multiple neighborhoods
- Infill and appropriate development of undeveloped land
- Residential, commercial, and mixed use



What else is LEED-ND? Entire developments of multiple buildings and developer-supplied infrastructure May be mixed-use, or entirely residential or commercial if adding diversity to surrounding area Will likely inform land-use component of other LEED rating systems What is the current status of LEED-ND? • 45-day comment period for LEED-ND Corresponding Committee on preliminary draft entitories a pitot period ended recently (sorry) When will it be available? • We hope to begin pilot in late 2006 luled for 2007

•Levels of certification depending on points earned (Certified, Silver, Gold, Platinum)
